# PRESS RELEASE

## **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER FOR THE TESCO EXPRESS WORKS ON HINCKLEY ROAD, LEICESTER FOREST EAST**

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order to include temporary road closures and temporary parking restrictions whilst works are being undertaken for the new Tesco Express on Hinckley Road, Leicester Forest East.

The following roads will be closed:

1. Kirby Lane from the junction with Forest Drive from the 20<sup>th</sup> January to the 10<sup>th</sup> February. For the duration of the Kirby Lane closure, parking restrictions will be in place on Barry Drive, Main Street and Station Road
2. Hinckley Road from the junction with Kirloe Avenue to the junction with Rutland Close from 8pm on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> February to 6am on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February. For the duration of the Hinckley Road closure parking restrictions will be in place on Kings Drive, Rushmere Walk and Stafford Leys.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via:- Whilst the closures are in place the following diversions will be signed:

1. Kirby Lane closure west bound traffic will be diverted via Kirby Lane, Station Road, Main Street, Ratby Lane, Hinckley Road, Kirby Muxloe and vice versa
2. Kirby Lane closure east bound traffic will be diverted via Hinckley Road, Kirby Muxloe Leicester Lane, Barns Way, Station Road, Desford; Desford Lane, Newtown Unthank, Hedgerow Lane, Station Road, Kirby Lane, Kirby Muxloe and vice versa
3. Hinckley Road closure, Hinckley Road A47, B582 Enderby, B4114 Enderby to A563, A563 from B4114 to the A47 and vice versa
